The younger and newer children are being introduced to many new lessons in "practice life", music, language, and zoology. The older children continue learning the countries in the continent maps, phonetic spelling with moveable alphabet letters, and we have introduced the decimal work by units: tens, hundreds, & thousands. Our group is developing in to a cohesive group of three year olds!

OUTSIDE CLASS

We have been working together during "Group Time" to learn letter & number recognition as well as letter sounds. We also learn a new Spanish word each week! We have mastered folding our blankets after nap. We enjoy puzzles & painting on rainy days. Please remember to provide bug spray for your child.

TODDLER CLASS

Our class has been working on signing and they are doing great! Some of the signs that they are starting to use correctly are "thank you", "more", "eat", and "cup".

TRANSITIONAL TODDLER CLASS

We are focusing on sitting at the table for snack and lunchtime. Please work on this at home by not allowing you child to walk around the house with food. Continue to let your child help with daily activities at home: putting dishes in the dishwasher, sweeping, vacuuming, cleaning tables, and picking up their toys.
